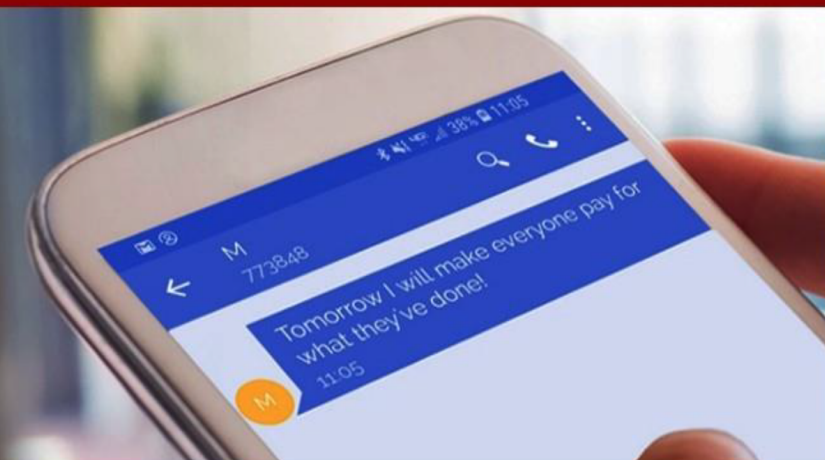


Identifying and Intercepting School Violence through Cyber-Investigation
